

In Review: Lord's Gym Ministries 2024 Report

This was a **year of growth** for Lord's Gym Ministries. We have experienced an uptick in Gospel touches, totaling more than 50,000 (20,000 more than 2023) with almost 6,000 spiritual advancements. These advancements include decisions to accept Christ, rededications and baptisms and life coaching/prayer.

Our afterschool and youth sports programs' attendance have increased drastically. Several young people accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior and our staff performed three youth baptisms in 2024.

We have waiting lists of children wanting to be a part of the experiences we offer. We need more "hands and feet" to meet those needs.

In 2024, we saw 5,663 volunteers put in more than 11,000 hours. It's important to note the spiritual growth of our volunteers too.

Debi, for example came to our afterschool program to serve in a community she was unfamiliar with. She wasn't sure what to expect. She promised to show up once a week. After a few hours with the kids, she's been showing up nearly every day! "I love the kids," she said. "I'm much closer to the Lord serving here."

In his letter, Paul, writes in Philippians 3:12: "Not that I have already attained, or am already perfected; but I press on, that I may lay hold of that for which Christ Jesus has also laid hold of me."








Our Impact Together: SEL of Youth

The nationally recognized organization, Hello Insight, helps us measure the impact of our youth ministry experiences. The third-party surveyor provides us with data-driven feedback that enables us to improve programming to more effectively serve our youth. In addition, we use these results to show potential partners and funders the effectiveness of our youth programming.

Year to date, 90 percent of our youth surveyed are advancing in one or more of the four core Social and Emotional Learning (SEL) areas including:

- Self-Control (2 Peter 1:6)
- Improved Academic Success (Ecclesiastes 10:10)
- Desire to Learn (Proverbs 1:5)
- Social Skills (Ephesians 4:29)
